#### **Explanation of Service Types**

**Traditional Funeral Service** is a funeral service which includes our full complement of staff, facility and vehicle fees to coordinate and carry out your wishes of having a casket (open or closed) visitation (maximum 4 hours), followed by a funeral service the same day or following day completed by procession or delivery to crematorium/cemetery.

For church/off-site services/visitation, facility charges will be deleted, equipment and additional staff services will apply.

Memorial Service / Celebration of Life / Service of Remembrance includes all required staff, facility and vehicle fees to carry out your wishes of having visitation the prior day or one hour preceding a service (no casket present) with an urn and/or flowers and photographs.

For church/off-site services/visitation, facility charges will be deleted, equipment and additional staff services will apply.

**Direct Disposition** is our basic service which includes minimal staff, facility and vehicle fees to carry out your wishes of having no visitation and no service with immediate delivery to cemetery or crematorium.

It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs or if the services extend beyond 48hours after a death occurs. Public viewing/visitation of deceased is not permitted without embalming and basic preparation. #### **DISBURSEMENTS**

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's Certificate \$ 75.00

Fee set by the Chief Coroner of Ontario for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place.

This fee also applies if the Coroner is required to issue a certificate to ship a body out of the Province.

#### **Municipal Death Registration**

London

\$ 40.00

Fee set and charged by the local municipality to register the death.

#### Out of Town Registration

\$ 35.00

Fee set and charged by the local municipality to register a death that took place in another municipality.

#### Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) - Consumer Protection Fee (CPF)

\$ 30.00

This fee is to provide BAO services of information on your options in bereavement services and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed. The BAO's regulatory work includes responding to public complaints, inspecting and providing guidance to bereavement businesses and professionals, which it licenses across Ontario to better serve you – the public. The BAO is wholly funded by licensee fees (not tax dollars)

Clergy Honorarium: An amount paid to the clergy/officiant for their services and taking time out of their and the churches regular schedule. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy/church, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

(suggested honorariums can range from \$200-\$500)

Additional Honorariums could include but not limited to: organist, caretaker, chanter, piper, alter servers, etc.

Newspaper or Radio Notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets. Charges can be based upon a flat daily rate or by the line.

Hairdressing: If the family chooses to have the services of a hairdresser they will assume all costs
